#### **Response:**

The college rigorously abides by the rules set forth by the UGC, NAAC, the Maharashtra government, and the affiliated SGBA University, Amravati from time to time. The college's organizational structure is led by the College Development Committee, which is made up of parent management members, teachers' and non-teaching staff members' representatives, nominated members, and the principal. The members of the IQAC are teachers, alumni association nominees, local bodies, business representatives, and student representatives. Members of the Council of Heads include the heads of each department. All permanent teachers make up the Staff Council. Head Clerk, Senior Clerks, Junior Clerks and Peons.

College administrators give faculty members the freedom and chances to organize and carry out a variety of academic, extracurricular, and extension programmes. Many academic staff members who are trained by university through the "Train the Trainer Program", have the chance to grow and improve their leadership abilities. Through IQAC, CDC, Staff Council and NSS Committee, the principal and faculty are devoted and consistently helpful.

## Service Rule:

On the college website, a perspective plan has been displayed. Through the participation of all stakeholders, IQAC has created certain high-quality policies, which are evaluated annually.

The college has decided to establish several courses that assist students in gaining additional life skills in a particular subject in order to carry out the Perspective Plan and to improve overall skills of students. Every college department was asked to create the curriculum and launch these Add-On/Certificate Courses with a minimum duration of 30 hours for this purpose.

## Introducing New Courses through NSQF:

In response to student demand and current developments, the college decided to create new courses. As a result, the college decided to start new courses, and three recommendations for NSQF-aligned, skill-based courses were presented. As a result, the linked university has given the institution authorization to offer NSQF in Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Botany, Zoology beginning in the 2020–21 academic year.
