1. Construction of dyke for dam (16/03/2022)

Volunteers of National Service SchemeDepartment constructed a construction of dyke and refilled the dam atadopted village Pimpalner. Two groups of NSS students were given the responsibility of replenishing the dam. After that, the dam wall was totally cleared of all vegetation, a wall about 95 to 100 feet long was drawn, and work began on it. On this wall, dirt, debris, and stones were flung. The volunteers cleared the lake of all silt and broken stones, throwing them in a public area. The excavation wall also received dirt.

Volunteers dug 15 to 20 feet long and 2 to 2.5 feet deep along the side of the pond and filled it. NSS volunteers deepening the lake and stones are carried to the edge. This year, due to the labor done by the volunteers, the water supply has definitely increased, which will help in increasing the water level of wells and borewells in the area. Also, water will be available for animals to drink and greenery will grow in the area.

The wall of the dam was 4 feet wide and filled 3 to 4 feet high from the bottom. This entire work took about 10 to 11 barasof digging. Also, if there was heavy rain, a pour outwas removed to excess of water. Seeing the work done by NSS volunteers together, all the NSS volunteers were happy and motivated and realized the importance of "Ekichebal" i.e. strength of all together.

Main roads, ancient forts, monuments, Hanuman temple, School, Gram Panchayat office of village were cleaned.





Shramadan (Labour Contribution/Donation):- In the adopted village Pimplaner, the pond was refilled to the west of the village. In this, the entire pond was voluntarily filled for 7 days. Also,

by digging at some places, the volunteers broke the stones. On the other hand, about 90 to 95 feet on the wall of the pond, the wall of the pond was raised by adding 5 to 3 feet of soil and stone pitching was also done. Also the shed was lowered in such a way that the water flows properly. Today the work of filling the pond was completed by putting stones on the entire wall of this lake. The water of this lake will benefit the village and the wild animals and other wild birds.
